## Dear Parents,


I hope this letter finds everyone well and with power! I just wanted to take a moment and update everyone on happenings at Meliora. We have been busily working on our building with the floors complete and the painter finishing up this week.







Once the painting is complete we will begin setting up our classroom spaces ensuring max capacites are enforced so that social distancing can be maintained.







To support all of our students and staff we have multiple forms of PPE available. While masks are not mandatory for our students, many of you have requested we work on the skill which we have been doing on distance learning and will continue when we return to school. Sample PPE which your child will see on staff can be found below:



As of this time, we are excited to say we are still planning to open full time with reduced staffing to support social distancing. What this means is that all related services (PT, OT, Speech) will be done virtually with ABA Instructors supporting the sessions. Please know, this was a very difficult decision but it is for the safety of all students and staff. This plan will be re-evaluated every two weeks and is not in any way long term. It is merely a "bridge" to get us back safely. Students will receive all mandated services whether they are in the building or at home as some of you have chosen to remain virtual while we transition.

In order to maintain distancing and follow CDC guidelines, students may be set up in new rooms and shifts in teacher assignments have been made in a few cases. You will be notified next week of any changes for

your student! Additionally, we are wishing our BCBA's Larissa and Trish well as they move on with their careers. I know they will be in touch if they haven't already. Trish will be finishing on August 14<sup>th</sup> while Larissa has kindly agreed to remain with us part time to support student's return to the building through the end of September. We are sad to see them go but know we will return fully staffed.

With regard to health protocols, you will receive the self-assessment which must be sent to school completed each morning. We will be following all CDC guidelines and health recommendations thus any child who is assessed to become ill during the day will be quarantined and must be picked up within an hour. You will be given information about health monitoring upon pick up.

You can opt to remain virtual or follow the full in-person model which we hope remains our plan.
